How many things can you see in the night sky? On a clear night you might see the Moon, some planets and thousands of sparkling stars. You can see even more with a telescope. You might see stars where before you only saw dark space. With bigger and bigger telescopes you can see more and more objects in the sky. And you can see those objects in more and more detail.

But scientists believe that there are some things in the sky that we will never see even with the biggest telescope in the world. That is because they are invisible and <u>mysterious</u>. They are dead stars which are called black holes. You might find it hard to imagine that stars die. After all, our Sun is a star. Year after year we see it up in the sky, burning brightly, giving us heat and light. The Sun certainly doesn't seem to be getting old or weak. But stars do burn out and die after billions of years.

As a star's gases burn, they give off light and heat. But when the gas runs out, the star stops burning and begins to die. As the star cools, the outer layers of the star pull in toward the center. The star squashes into a smaller and smaller ball. If the star is very small, it ends up as a cold, dark ball called a black dwarf. If the star is very big, it becomes lesser and lesser until it's packed together tighter than anything else in the universe.

Imagine if the Earth were crushed until it was the size of a tiny marble. That's how tightly this dead star, a black hole, is packed. What pulls the star in toward its center with such power? It's the same force that pulls you down when you jump - the force called gravity. A black hole is so tightly packed that its gravity sucks in everything even light. The light from a black hole can never come back to your eyes. That's why you see nothing but blackness.

So the next time you stare up at the night sky, remember: there's more in the sky than meets the eye!



They continued to push the limits to get their observations, going closer to the volcano and staying longer during an eruption. In 1991 Mount Pinatubo in the Philippines surprised the world. On June 15, it erupted after standing silent for 500 years. Mt. Pinatubo is a volcano, but the people living near it never expected it to wake up. The eruption was the second most powerful eruption of the twentieth century. More than a million people had to leave their homes, and between 700 and 900 people were killed. Only a few years later, though, life was back to normal and people were once again building homes and working in the shadow of the volcano.

People might live near a volcano because it is beautiful, or because a large city already exists there. They need to move to this city to find jobs and feed their families. Some people also live near volcanoes because the land near a volcano is good for farming. Volcanoes <u>release</u> ash from the Earth. The ash is good for growing plants. Whatever the reason, most people who live near volcanoes probably do not realise that the volcano is dangerous.

Volcanoes and their surrounding environment are beautiful places to live, work and create. The number of people moving into volcanic <u>hazardous</u> areas is increasing in post-industrial as well as developing countries. Southern Italy is an example. Mt.
